Conversion of Electricity Used at the Mizuho Lease Building to Renewable Energy

We are pleased to announce that, as of May 1, 2022, all electricity used at the Mizuho Lease Building (Toranomom, Minato-ku, Tokyo), where our head office and Group companies are located, has been converted to renewable energy sources (hereinafter referred to as "renewable energy").

The Mizuho Leasing Group aims to create a sustainable society with the "creator of a sustainable society" as the vision (what we aspire to be) in our management philosophy.

One of the materiality issues of the Group is to "contribute to the realization of a decarbonized society", and in addition to contributing to the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions through our business activities, such as solar and hydroelectric power generation, we are also working to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from the Group's business activities.

Converting the electricity used at the Mizuho Lease Building, which has been the largest source of greenhouse gas emissions among the Group's emissions, to renewable energy is a major step forward.
