Donation of Vegetables Harvested at the Indoor Plant Farm, Ibuki Kawaguchi Farm

Mizuho Leasing Company, Limited (hereinafter "Mizuho Leasing") announces that we have donated vegetables harvested at Ibuki Kawaguchi Farm to Second Harvest Japan as part of our social contribution activities.





Ibuki Kawaguchi Farm was established to promote further employment for people with disabilities, and currently has seven workers and one manager who grow and process herbal teas and vegetables.

Second Harvest Japan was established in March 2002 and is the first food bank in Japan. It receives food that is still edible but not being used for various reasons and distributes it to welfare facilities such as orphanages and maternal and child support facilities, as well as to individuals in need, and develops various support systems and conducts activities to enable all people to have enough food to live in peace regardless of disasters or economic conditions. We donated stockpiled emergency food through Second Harvest Japan in November 2021.

In May 2022, we will hire three new employees with disabilities at Ibuki Kawaguchi Farm and promote the cultivation of vegetables, etc., and we also plan to continue our regular vegetable donation activities.

The Mizuho Leasing Group is committed to promoting the employment of people with disabilities, donating to children's homes, single-parent households, and other people in need, and making other internal and external efforts toward a symbiotic society in which people support each other.
