

Response to the Law for Recycling of Specified Kinds of Home Appliances (Home Appliances Recycling Law)

Under the Law for Recycling of Specified Kinds of Home Appliances, hereafter written as “Home Appliances Recycling Law,” enforced April 1st 2001, recycling of used home appliances is obligated for the customers, retailers, and manufacturers with dividing roles. With the law, collection and conveyance fee and recycling fee are to be paid by the customers.

1. Collection and Conveyance Fee

When we, as a retailer under the Home Appliances Recycling Law, collect and convey the used home appliances, the prices are as follows:

List of Collection and Conveyance Fee Responsible by the Customer (per device)

As of October 2019

Intended Home Appliances	Collection and Conveyance Fee (excl. Tax)
Air conditioner	¥8,000
TV (CRT-based/Liquid crystal/Plasma)	¥5,000
Refrigerator / Freezer	¥10,000
Washing Machine/ Laundry Dryer	¥7,000

The price above is based upon standard situation. Additional fee may be required under the conditions as follows:

- When the collection takes place in the remote area or isolated islands.
- When any of special operations such as usage of crane is required at the time of collection.
- When the demounting operation is required for the intended appliances.
- When the collection date and time is appointed.
- When other means of special operation is required

The collection and conveyance fee is claimed by the collection operator.

2. Recycling Fee

Please confirm to us or manufacturers about the recycling fee beforehand; the recycling fee that the customer owes differs according to the manufacturers.

*Please pay the recycling fee at the post office to issue “Recycling ticket for the home appliances” prior to the visit by the collection operator.
